We wish to thank her for many years of service and to wish her many happy years to come.

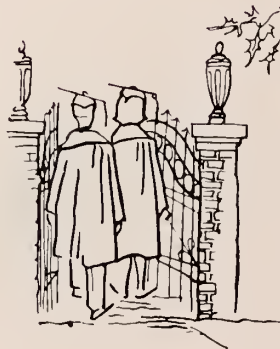

studying, playing, learning which all combine to give us the most triumphant moment of our lives—our graduation.

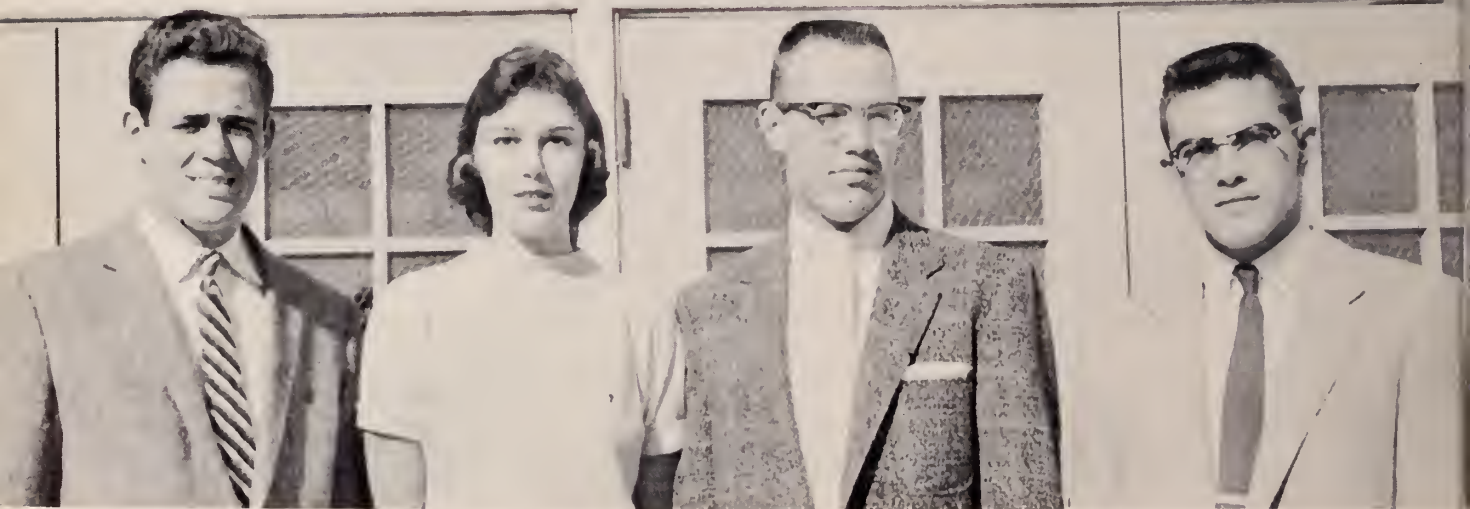

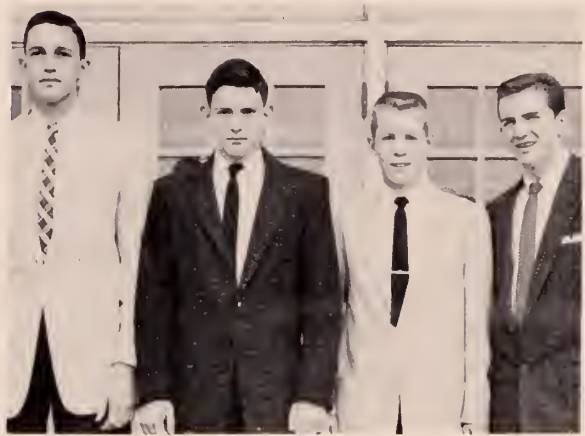
THE SOPHOMORE CLASS
