Our aspirations high.

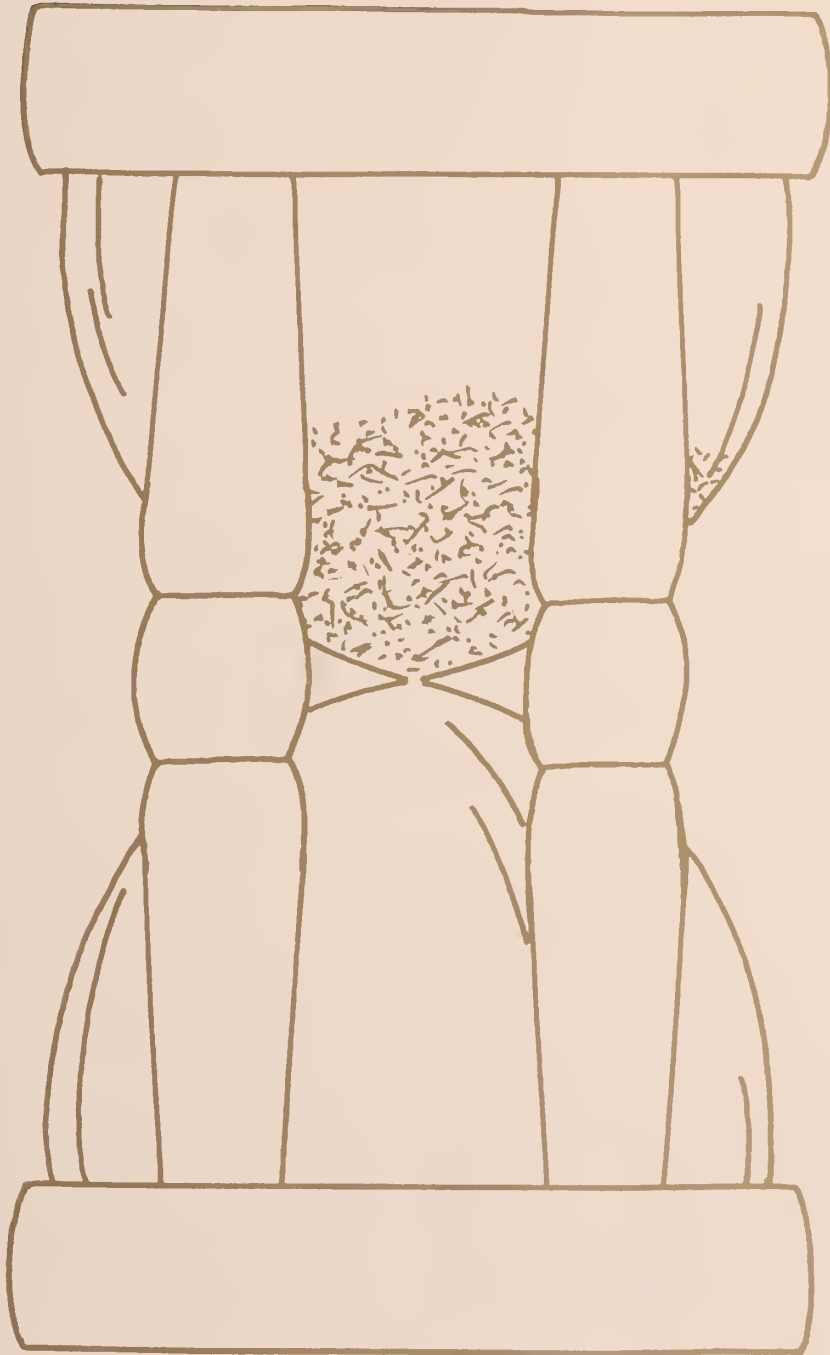
Wisdom is our tool of work.

The Junior year is one of the most exciting years in high school life. Juniors receive their class rings which is a symbol of high school days.

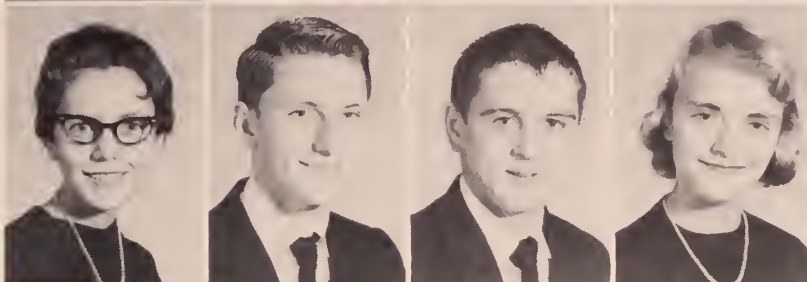
This past year the Junior Class had a float in the homecoming parade, presented an assembly to the school, and entertained the Senior Class with a Prom.
