Welcome to Lake Jackson, one of the oldest
reservoirs in Georgia. Lake Jackson was formed
in 1910 with the completion of Lloyd Shoals
Dam and a hydroelectric plant by the Central
Georgia Power Company. The plant was
operated by the Georgia Power Company
until 1976, when that company
merged with the Georgia Power Company in a
newly formed state electric system. The
Lloyd Shoals Hydro Plant has been in
continuous operation since 1911.

Lake Jackson covers approximately 4,750 acres
and has 135 miles of shoreline. Its waters are
fed by the South, Yellow, and Alcovy Rivers,
and by Tusculum Creek. The Ocmulgee River
emerges below the dam.

Lake Jackson provides numerous recreational
opportunities including swimming, boating,
fishing, tubing, camping and more. Bass,
crappie, bluegill, and catfish are plentiful,
giving fishermen plenty of opportunities.

Information from the United States Geological
Survey, National Cartographic Information
Center, and the owners and operators of Lake
Jackson indicate that no accurate underwater
contour information is available for the lake.
Although other map companies may include
contours for Lake Jackson, Kingfisher Maps
continues its standards of accuracy and will
not include underwater features without
official verification.
