The Yadkin River comes from a spring in Blowing Rock N.C. in the Blue Ridge Mountains. The portion of river below the Uwharrie River is known as the Pee Dee. In the Yadkin Watershed there are four main lakes: High Rock, Tuckertown, Badin, and Tillery.

These two are the middle of the four and have a primary purpose for producing power for the production of aluminum. Badin Works of Aluminum Company of America is the main consumer of the electricity produced. The dams and reservoirs are owned by Yadkin Inc., a wholly-owned subsidiary of Alcoa.

In Badin Lake and Tuckertown Reservoir there are many species of sport-fish. Large-Mouth Bass, Striped Bass, White Bass, Crappie, Catfish, and Blue Gill are the most popular to fish for. Local sporting shops such as Hoot's Outdoors in Albemarle are good sources for various fishing information.

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
